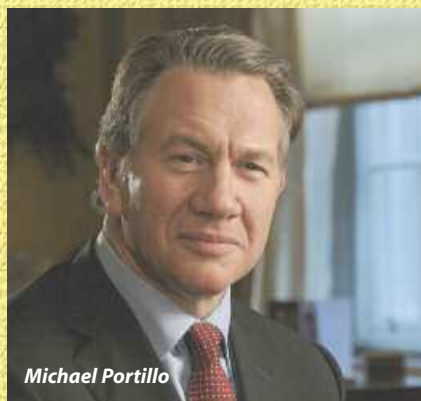

Michael Nyman is an English composer, pianist, librettist, writer, musicologist, photographer and film-maker whose work encompasses opera, concert music and film soundtracks of which *The Draughtsman's Contract* and *The Piano* are the best-known. Since founding the Michael Nyman Band in 1977, which tours the world, he has worked with leading film directors and has collaborated with artists such as Mary Kelly, Damon Albarn, Carsten Nicolai and the recent Oscar winning *Man on Wire* star Phillippe Petit. An exhibition of his photographs and video-works is currently at the De La Warr Pavilion, Bexhill. He has released 13 albums of his music on MN Records.
